## TELEMENTS OF SUCCESSFUL COLLECTIVE LEADERSHIP

- **NETWORKS:** Forming strategies for growth and enhancing member service requires a variety of expertise from across departments or outside partners. Collective leadership encourages intercommunication between contributors.
- MUTUAL ACCOUNTABILITY: Use group communication to foster strong cohesion and help individuals within teams stay on track with their assigned responsibilities.
- AUTHENTICITY: Relationship building that encourages open communication and employees to be themselves creates strong, confident teams. Create opportunities to connect as a team and be sure to invite everyone's input.
- **EMPOWERMENT:** Swift, effective responses require independent action. Align tasks to employee strengths, ensure applicable training/resources are available, and clearly designate when employees are expected to act on their own.
- **LEARNING:** Internal training, industry conferences, continuing education, and mentorship can help all employees perform better and discover opportunities for innovation as well as personal and group advancement.
- **EXPERIMENTATION:** Introduce new ideas and test them. Review results regularly as a team to determine what new tactics may be needed.
- **MEMBERS/COMMUNITY FIRST:** Make community and member needs the basis for forming organizational and group goals. This helps ensure credit union services remain relevant as community and member needs change.
